

The historic rural building in the foothills of the Jeseníky Mountains presents the production of small agricultural tools in an exposition of forestry and life in the countryside. As part of special tours, you can try using a washboard or basket weaving.







Travel back to the 16th century to hear the stories of the soldiers who guarded the ancient Silesian-Hungarian border against smugglers and enemy raids.





Take a special boat trip on the youngest dam in the Czech Republic, called the Jeseníky Sea. Become the captain of a sightseeing electric boat for a while.







These are some of the experiences that you can look forward to on the Technotrail, a unique project connecting exceptional industrial monuments across North Moravia. The Technotrail will let you discover the raw beauty of a region whose natural riches locals have been striving to conquer for centuries. You will hear the stories of industrialists, metallurgists, miners, textile workers, railroad workers, hatters, foresters, millers, and soldiers. To top it off, you will be able to experience the stories yourself.




Centred around the Bolt Tower, an observation tower built atop a blast furnace, the unique Dolní Vítkovice industrial complex is where coal was mined and pig iron was produced from 1828 to 1998. Now an exceptional educational, cultural, and social centre, you can have fun with interactive exhibitions from the world of technology.






Follow the story of coal in the Ostrava region -- to Landek. At the largest mining museum in the Czech Republic, you'll find Ostrava's oldest mine shaft, the Anselm Mine, where former miners will introduce you to coal mining and take you for a ride down the shaft in a lift that they once used.







MICHAL COALMINE


At the Michal Coalmine, at the opposite end of Ostrava from Landek, you will have the persistent feeling that the miners never left Perhaps they will join you in the chain locker room or snack dispensary! Book one of the special night guided tours.







Visit the only museum in the Czech Republic that traces wagon production. The museum tour is complemented by an exhibition of the history of aircraft production and a model railway for the little ones.



Experience a steam train ride through the forgotten picturesque landscape of Osoblažsko down the most winding railway in the Czech Republic. You might even encounter Hotzenplotz the Robber or throw coal into the firebox of the steam engine.



Explore one of only two publicly accessible slate mines in the Czech Republic with your children and chisel a heart out of slate!
