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


Welcome to the Moravian-Silesian Region






Autocamp Frenštát pod Radhoštěm

AMAZING PANORAMAS

Take the cable car or walk to Pustevny. In addition to amazing folk architecture and picturesque views, the unique Stezka Valaška (Wallachian Trail) with a length of 660 metres and a height of over 15 metres awaits you. It was built in 1945 days and the builders used about 21,000 screws, bolts and other fasteners. They created a unique viewpoint, which includes the suspended Himalayan Walkway and a glass platform that makes you feel you are suspended high above the ground for a moment. You can see as far as the Jeseníky and Velká Fatra Mountains.





If you're looking for a good outing for the kids, take them to **Boboffka**. At 620 m above sea level, you will have the mountains in the palm of your hand. The way down is almost one kilometre long and you can regulate the speed yourself depending on how partial you are to adrenaline rushes and wind in your face. You can supplement your visit to the track, for example, with a bike ride along cycle path 6007. On this cycle path you can see the wooden Church of St. Procopius and St. Barbora from the 17th century in Kunčice pod Ondřejníkem. It was brought to Kunčice from Subcarpathian Rus in 1931.

TIMES LONG PAST

Get to know the fascinating yet harsh life in picturesque Wallachia at the turn of the 19th and 20th centuries. It is almost a tourist's duty to visit the Wallachian Open Air **Museum**. It is the largest complex of its kind in the Czech Republic, and features several sightseeing loops. At any rate, don't miss the basic route (the Little Wooden Town), the oldest part of the museum. It was opened to the public in 1925 and has been gradually developing since then. The museum displays unique timbered buildings transferred from where they were built, as well as copies and reconstructions of historical buildings.

MYTHICAL RADHOŠT'

Go to the top of the Pustevny ridge - the mythical **Radhošt'** Mountain. If you want to save your strength, use the cable car from Trojanovice or the electric bikes that are available for rent. Pustevny is the most popular tourist resort in the Beskydy area, and the statue of the god Radegast, which you can find on the way to the top of the mountain, is the most famous symbol of the entire Moravian-Silesian region. Be sure to visit the Libušín Restaurant with its unique interior. Libušín and the nearby Hotel Maměnka were designed by the prominent architect Dušan Jurkovič.

WATER PARADISE

During your holiday, enjoy a rest day with your family at the nearby Aquapark Frenštát pod Radhoštěm. In the modern waterworld paradise, you can enjoy a 60-metre-long and almost 6-metre-high water slide, a 13-metre-high slide, climbing nets above the water and a paddling pool. Children and adults alike will appreciate the watery activities on offer here.

Bolt Tower

THE HISTORY OF MINING RIGHT NEXT TO THE CAMPSITE

If you are interested in the history of mining, come and see the mine rescue exhibition at Landek, one of the largest of its kind in the world. Historical gems of international importance include the oldest surviving breathing apparatus from 1884 and the Siebe-Gorman heavy diving set from 1920. Children can try out rescue training on the rescue training polygon and become heroes of the mine for a while. You can experience authentic "digging down the mine" during a tour of the underground exposition, which is a cultural monument of the Anselm

Mine, dominated by a 40-metre headframe. There are a total of 250 metres of tunnels underground at a depth of nine metres. And if you want to learn even more about the history of mining in the Ostrava Region, then become a miner in the former **Michal coal mine** in Ostrava-Michálkovice. You will get the strongest feeling that the miners never left the area, and that they will join you in the chain locker room, the "lamp room" or the canteen. On special tours, you can also see the mine at night! Michal Mine

MORE THAN 430 ANIMAL SPECIES IN ONE PLACE

Take the whole family to the second-largest zoo in the country. More than 5,000 animals are kept here over an area of almost 100 hectares. The newest exhibitions include the Evolution Pavilion with chimpanzees, cats and other West African species, Tanganyika with hippos and crocodiles, Chitwan with bears and langurs, Papua with Papuan reptiles and fish, and the giant La Pampa walkthrough aviary with condors and other South American animals. The complex also features a botanical garden, which provides an environment for rest and relaxation.

It consists of three trails - the Water Trail, the Forest Trail and the Shadow Trail - with a total length of about 6 kilometres, connected with zoological expositions. And if a walk through the vast grounds is too much for you, take a ride on the safari express and enjoy watching the animals from the comfort of a train. There are also many play areas for children. There are hundreds of benches. dozens of relaxation areas, and a restaurant open all year round, so you can spend the whole day here. The option of animal encounters accompanied by our expert guides just adds to the excitement.

A VIEW THAT TAKES YOUR BREATH AWAY

Climb to the heights on the unique industrial superstructure of the No. 1 blast furnace. The famous **Bolt Tower** in Ostrava's Dolní Vítkovice rises to a height of 80 metres. Iron was produced here in the past, but today the site is given over to visitors. An adrenaline trail winds around the glass cylinder of the superstructure. The footbridge resembles a helix, and the name ,Bolt' is more than apt, as the world-famous runner Usain Bolt actually opened this extraordinary construction.

Štramberk

FAMOUS EARS

Discover the picturesque town under the Beskydy Mountains, with the pleasant aroma of the Štramberk ears gingerbreads. The small town with its labyrinth of narrow streets attracts tourists with its rich history, mysterious legends and wooden folk architecture. **Štramberk** was founded in the 14th century by the brother of Emperor Charles IV, Henry of Luxembourg. While wandering through the romantic corners of the town, you will be intoxicated by the ubiquitous gingerbread smell of Štramberk ears, which are baked in many cottages here as a reminder of the victory of the locals over the Mongol hordes who plundered the

region in the 13th century. You can recognize the town from afar by its characteristic tower called Trúba. However, if you have already been to Trúba, book a tour of the town with the tempting title Treasures of blacksmiths, malters and confectioners at www. technotrasa.cz. During the tour, you will not only bake your own ear, find out details about Šipka Cave. where the oldest human settlement in the country is documented, but vou will also learn how Štramberk is linked to gold! Everybody has heard about Štramberk's Trúba, but the legends of pixies and treasure that shroud the tower and town are less well known.

Tatra Truck Museum

TATRA KOPŘIVNICE TRUCK MUSEUM BÍL

The car with which Karel Loprais won the Dakar Rally, the car in which Zikmund and Hanzelka crossed the world, and the legendary Drtikolka. These are just snippets from the interactive exhibition mapping the production history of Tatra - one of the oldest automobile factories in the world. Fans of modern technology will be delighted by the fact that the exhibition is complemented by augmented reality, so smart phones at the ready! You can also look forward to a guided tour of the expositions, or enjoy them without a guide - you can try out, for example, crankstarting, leaf spring suspension and driving on brush roads.

BÍLÁ HORA

An observation tower reminiscent of a strand of DNA rises to a height of 43 metres on the border of **Kopřivnice and Štramberk**. Of the many paths that lead to the top of Bila Hora, the most beautiful is the Sunny Path decorated with the signs of the zodiac. Let yourself be surprised by the impressive view of the Beskydy and Jeseníky Mountains.

TIPS FOR TRIPS in the foothills of the

Jeseníky Mountains

WAITING FOR A SIGNAL

Discover this beautiful corner of the Moravian-Silesian Region near the border with Poland. If you want to soak up some peace and quiet, then the seeminaly forgotten foothills of the Jeseníky Mountains is the right place for you. For example, climb the unique twotower Hraniční vrch observation tower. The tower a unique iron structure featuring a connecting metal footbridge with spectacular views, making you feel you are floating in the air. The observation tower is located a few metres from

the Czech-Polish border near the town of Albrechtice. Originally, the tower was supposed to be used for signal transmission, but the town bought the unused buildings from Czech Radio Communications and a unique observation tower was created. You can reach it by following the blue hiking trail and there are several wooden attractions for children in the forest near the tower. The picturesque Fairytale Trail to Mole's Well, which will be especially appreciated by smaller children, is also nearby.

A CIRCUIT OF ATTRACTIONS

Enjoy a beautiful trip and get to know the surroundings of Albrechtice. The route, which connects a total of five attractions in the area, is 28 kilometres long and moderately demanding, but can be managed by families with children. The circuit connects Dubí Hill, Pilgrimage Hill, the Burkvíz Ruins, Linhart Château and the Hraniční vrch observation tower. On the route, stop for example at Linhart Château to see a beautiful original fortress from the 14th century. The reconstruction at the beginning of the 18th century created a beautiful Baroque mansion. Nowadays, thanks to its dedicated warden, the château offers several exhibitions during the season and children will appreciate the beautiful colourful thematic sculptures created by the warden himself using special techniques.

Take a bike ride **through the** Osoblaho district and discover some beautiful natural areas in the countryside. For example, plan a route to the Osoblažský výběžek promontory and get to know a remote part of the region. Beautiful views of fields, forests and meadows in both the Czech and Polish parts await you. And if you want to discover something new, plan a route through the now extinct village of Pelhřimovy. In the middle of the natural wilderness you will find the 13th century St. George's Church, which used to mark the centre of the vanished

FORGOTTEN BEAUTY

village. After February 1948, the Ministry of the Interior decided for ideological reasons to ban built-up areas within 300 metres of the state border and had the village gradually demolished. Only two of the original 70 houses have survived to the present day, and they officially belong to the neighbouring Slezské Rudoltice. The church is gradually being renovated by members of the Duha Movement and the site is used for cultural events because of its unique atmosphere. In Pelhřimovy you will feel like you are in another world.

DID VERNE LIVE IN OSTRAVA?

Can you imagine any other city where Jules Verne would have liked to live more than Ostrava? After all, in his books he seems to have described iconic places in Ostrava! The steel town is **Dolní Vítkovice** with all its attractions: the World of Technology, the Gong gasworks, the blast furnaces with the Bolt Tower and a branch of the National Museum of Agriculture. The golden volcano is the **Ema slag heap**, a unique, still smoking and steaming hill that gives you an unforgettable view. A journey to the centre of the earth, or rather a journey into the bowels of the former Ostrava mines, awaits visitors at **Landek Park**, a mining museum where you can actually go underground into the mine. UPWARDS TO THE JEWELS OF OPAVA SILESIA

In the Opava Region, you can easily visit **several châteaus** without travelling too far, as well as the **oldest museum in the Czech Republic**! Right in the centre of the white pearl of Silesia, as Opava is called, you will find the **Silesian Museum**, which is actually four years older than the National Museum. One of the most fairytalelike châteaus in our country is undoubtedly **Hradec nad Moravicí**, which you may remember from the recent fairytale The Princess and Half a Kingdom, where it was

used as the seat of Prince Egon played by Jakub Prachar. A visit to Radun will evoke the atmosphere of the châteaus in the Loire region of France. The silhouette of the aristocratic mansion is reflected on the calm surface of the pond in the château park. The Baroque Kravaře Château with its large landscaped park, part of which is now used for golf, will also captivate you with its extravagantly decorated chapel. We recommend taking advantage of the special tours for children, which are organized in Kravaře every Friday during the holidays!

Mionší Primeval Forest

THE ROAD TO A PRIMEVAL FOREST

Visit the **Mionší** National Nature Reserve near Jablunkov, one of the best preserved forest complexes in the Moravian part of the Western Carpathians. It covers almost 170 hectares. You can admire this gem of Beskydy nature thanks to a guided nature trail, where you can see a mosaic of forest stands, small forest meadows, springs and rocky outcrops. You will find yourself in the true wilderness of the legendary Beskydy primeval forest.

LOMNÁ RIDES WITH CHILDREN

If you are looking for a relaxing bike ride that you can even manage with children, head to Jablunkov and try the new route to Dolní and Horní Lomná. About 12 kilometres long, the trail is perfect for a bike ride with children. There's minimal climbing and you'll mostly be riding on level ground. From Jablunkov head towards Dolní Lomná. You will connect to cycle route number 6082. In Dolní Lomná, the new viaduct means you can easily cross the river where the cycle path follows the flow of the River Lomňanka. On the way, you'll pass

the URSUS experience centre, where there are several expositions focused on Beskydy nature and also an interesting garden. The URSUS centre is part of the network of information centres of the Beskydy Protected Landscape Area. In the centre of Dolní Lomná, you can stop at Lomná Museum, which is housed in the Lomná schoolhouse dating from 1852. You can end your trip at the children's playground or in a pleasant café in Horní Lomná.

A NEW BRANCH OF THE MUSEUM OF THE TĚŠÍN REGION IN **JABLUNKOV**

Visit the new Tri-Border Museum in Těšín Silesia. The museum is located in a renovated listed building. The "Prince's House" is one of the oldest brick buildings not only in the Silesian town of Jablunkov, but also in this part of the former Principality of Těšín. A permanent exhibition called Landscape and People has been prepared for visitors, which will present the centuries-old coexistence of nature and man



QUEEN OF THE MORAVIAN-SILESIAN BESKYDY MOUNTAINS

Olešná is ideally situated for trips to the nearby Beskydy Mountains. So put on your hiking boots and go, for example, to **Lysá Hora**. From Lysá Hora, you can enjoy an amazing view of the Beskydy Mountains, the Jeseníky Mountains and the Western and High Tatra Mountains. After hiking up to 1323 m above sea level, you can refresh yourself at Bezručova Chata or Maratonec Chata. For example, plan your route so that you stop at the lvančena stone cairn built in memory of the Scouts martyred during World War II. On the way back, stop by the beautiful Satinský Waterfalls.



JANÁČEK'S HUKVALDY

If you prefer relaxing bike rides, then cycling path number 6006 will lead you from Olešná Dam through the charming surroundings of the Palkovice hills to the Na Mlýně area, which Leoš Janáček liked to visit and was his inspiration when composing. From there, continue along the cycling path to Hukvaldy, where you will discover the house that Janáček bought in 1921. Today you can find a memorial to the composer here. You must not miss **Hukvaldy Castle**. The path to it leads through a forest with fallow deer and you'll pass the famous statue of Bystrouška the fox.

You will have a lot of fun even if you don't stray from **Olešná Dam**. Around the large body of water, you can go roller blading, or on bikes and scooters, which you can rent on site. At any time during the ride, you can stop and take a dip right in the reservoir. But if you are more a fan of swimming pools, head to the local aguapark. It offers a large number of waterbased attractions. You can also have great fun at Adventure Golf Olešná, an 18-hole mini-golf facility.





MIRACLES LIKE IN LOURDES

Do you like mysterious stories that defy explanation? This is what awaits you in Frýdek-Místek at the Basilica of the Visitation of the

Virgin Mary. This place from the 18th century is known as the Silesian Lourdes. Like the famous pilgrimage site in France, it is shrouded in tales of miraculous healings and unexplained apparitions. Whether you believe in the supernatural or not, one thing is certain - the basilica has an unusual atmosphere and is well worth a visit. For more mysterious stories, head to the Chapel of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross in Hájka with its spring that supposedly has miraculous effects.

THE BESKYDY MUSEUM IN FRÝDEK CHATEAU

Discover the history of the Moravian-Silesian Beskydy Mountains and the Pobeskydská Uplands and find out some interesting facts about the local nature. The Museum of Beskydy in Frýdek- Místek is located in Frýdek Château and offers several permanent exhibitions. The château was built between 1327 and 1339 as a Gothic castle over the River Ostravice.

THE HIGHEST PEAK OF THE SILESIAN BESKYDY MOUNTAINS

Velká Čantoryje is located at 995 metres above sea level and is the northernmost and highest peak of the Silesian Beskydy Mountains. A 29-metre-high steel observation tower and a refreshment cabin were built on the top of the ridge in 2002. If you climb the 118 steps, the tower offers magnificent views of three countries - the Czech Republic, Poland and Slovakia. Did you know what legend pertains to Velká Čantoryja? There are sleeping knights in the heart of the mountain who will wake up when the Silesian people are in their time of need.

THE HISTORY OF THE TĚŠÍN REGION

Come and admire the beauty of the Těšín Silesia Region. In Jablunkov you will discover, for example, the unique **World Bible Museum**. The museum in the Old Monastery presents the Bible and its message. There are hundreds of interesting Bibles for children and adults in dozens of languages and dialects. In Jablunkov you can also visit, for example, the **Archive of Military History of Těšín Silesia** and its permanent exhibition on World War II.

Take a peek behind the scenes at the **Hyundai plant**, one of Europe's most modern, during a factory tour. The entire production process from sheet metal to test drive takes around 20 hours. GAME RESERVE AT THE CHATEAU

Take a look at the beautiful château built in 1906 by the Archbishop of Olomouc as a resting place with the possibility of hunting trips in the vast surrounding forests. The hunting lodge is a wooden construction with a shingle roof and has retained its original appearance to this day. Near the château, you can also visit a game reserve with wild boar, mouflon, and varieties of red, fallow and roe deer.

STINKING HEALTH

Follow the green hiking trail from the centre of Bílá to the valley of Velké Smradlava and the Smradlava sulphur spring. You don't have to worry about missing this water source because you will recognise it by its characteristic aroma. And feel free to drink to your heart's content. The water is drinkable despite the white coating deposited around it and the purple colour of the bacteria. It even has healing effects. It helps with stomach problems and joint pain.

SŮKENICKÁ OBSERVATION TOWER

Climb the 40-metre-high observation tower at the Bumbálka border crossing. From the top of Čarták you will be able to see the beauty of the Moravian-Silesian Beskydy Mountains. A total of 137 steps lead up the tower and it is decorated with an unusual octagonal platform.

VIEWS FROM THE VOLCANO

Take the hiking trail to Velký **Roudný**. The marked path leads from the car park by the church in the village of Roudno. The old historical trail winds up to the very top of the stratovolcano, where there is a wooden lookout tower and a chapel. Along the way, you can relax on wooden benches and enjoy the varied views of the landscape, including the Slezská Harta Dam. At the border of the forest, the path turns into a hiking trail leading to a memorial to the victims of World War I. After individual stops on the Way of the Cross, it ends at the very top of the hill with magnificent views of the surrounding area.

You can take a leisurely bike trip of about 40 kilometres around the newest dam in the country. During a trip around the Slezská Harta Dam, you can always relax and refresh with a swim. After a while, the trail leaves the road and takes you to meadows with beautiful views of the opposite shore of the reservoir. Note the church, which is the only thing left from the flooded village of Karlovec. You can make your trip more pleasant with a sightseeing cruise on the Harta electro-boat, which also has sufficient capacity for bicycles

NATURAL MONUMENTS

The whole area around Slezská Harta is interwoven with natural monuments that are remnants of the former volcanic activity. Discover, for example, the **Venus Volcano**, a now extinct Quaternary volcano located above the village of Mezina, south of Bruntál. At the top you will find a flat crater and side craters with lava caves. The red-brown colour of the soil serves as a reminder of the past volcanic activity.

TECHNICAL MONUMENT

Take a look at the preserved limestone kiln. It is located about 2 kilometres from the village of Razová and was built in 1912 from rough quarried stone. Limestone has probably been mined in this area for centuries and was used for construction purposes as well as for bleaching laundry. Limestone was also used for the ironworks in nearby Roudno. In 2001, the furnace was repaired by the Old Bruntál Club and opened to the public.

MOUNTAIN THOUGHTS

Take a look around the region from the highest mountain in Moravia. **Praděd** is also the highest peak of the Hrubý and Nízký Jeseník Mountains. A television transmitter with a restaurant and an observation tower stands on the mountain's summit at 1492 metres. The upper platform of the transmitter is also the highest point in the Czech Republic. You can see Lysá Hora, Sněžka and Radhošt' from the 80-metre-high viewpoint. Several hiking trails and cycle paths lead to Praděd. Probably the most famous route starts at **Hvězda** – a mountain pass above the Karlova Studánka Spa. If you have a moment, take a tour of this picturesque village,

which offers the cleanest air for far and wide. And if you stop by the historic Slezský dům building you will immediately remember a scene from the famous Czech film I Enjoy the World with You (S tebou mě baví svět). This is where some scenes from the best Czech comedy of the last century were filmed.

TO THE BÍLÁ OPAVA WATERFALLS

Enjoy the beautiful unspoiled nature. Take a trip to the Bílá Opava Educational Trail and discover the most beautiful mountain stream in the Jeseníky Mountains. Bridges, wooden ladders and footbridges await you on the 6-kilometre-long route. The educational trail under Praděd

Kopřivná Trails

leads along the wild and narrow river, which creates cascades and waterfalls. The biggest of them is almost 8 metres high! Even children can manage the trail if they are used to walking - and with the prospect of blueberry dumplings in one of the mountain huts at the finish line, it will be a perfect trip. You can even extend your route, for example, by going on a circuit of about 12 kilometres. Start the trip in Karlova Studánka, follow the yellow or blue trail to the crossroads above the Bíla Opava Waterfalls, then continue in the direction towards Ovčárna and you will get to Karlova Studánka again.

GOLD PANNING LIKE IN THE WILD WEST

Let yourself be enchanted by the beauty of the nature of the Zlatohorska Region. Zlaté Hory originated as a mining settlement on gold deposits and the gold rush era is introduced to you here through an openair museum and an educational trail. Go to the **Biskupská Kupa** peak with an observation tower. which is the oldest stone lookout in the Jeseníky Mountains. Above Zlaté Hory you will also discover a beautiful pilgrimage site. The foundation stone of the new Church of Our Lady of Help was consecrated by Pope John Paul

In the surroundings, you will also find the Rejvíz guesthouse and the path starting from it to the Great Moss Lake in the middle of the peat bogs.

EXPERIENCE A HEALTHY RUSH OF ADRENALINE

The Kopřivná Bikepark in Malé Morávka boasts a total of 12 kilometres of trails. The local Family Trails can easily be conquered even with children. You can also go there on mountain scooters or three-wheelers, which are available to rent. For young bikers, there is a Funtrail with banked turns. And if you're a fit and competent biker, try Downhill, where you'll tackle challenging terrain full of tree roots, obstacles and jumps.

TRAVELLING BY STEAM

HISTORY AT HAND

Take a trip unlike any other with your children to the forgotten landscape of **Osoblaha**. This is a unique steam-train ride on the country's most scenic narrowgauge railway! That is why the track is part of the Technotrail, which connects unique technical monuments in the region. During the steam train ride you will meet a real conductor, the stationmaster and maybe even the leaendary robber Hotzenplotz, named after the German name for Osoblaha. Osoblaha is a unique line and saw its first steam train in 1898!

In Osoblaha you will find one of the oldest Jewish cemeteries in the country. More than 300 tombstones have been preserved here and it is said to have already existed back in the 14th century. The Jewish population had begun leaving the town even before the Second World War. The red hiking trail from the railway station will lead you to this cultural monument. The path along the city walls is a pleasant walk even in the hot summer. But if you still need cooling down, you can go to the Osoblaha swimming pool. You can learn more about the history of the region at the Osoblaha Museum.

Silesian Rudoltice Château

THE SILESIAN VERSAILLES

Did you know what the châteaus in **Silesian Rudoltice** and Versailles in France have in common? At first glance, perhaps a mutual resemblance. Rest assured, however, that Rudoltice offers equally eccentric tales and stories that the Sun King himself would have loved at Versailles. The château came to prominence in the first half of the 18th century thanks to Count Albert Hodic. He thought of making the château a place for the elite from all over Europe. Using his wife's money, he started to rebuild the château in the style of the residence of the French kings and he was particularly fond of the

gardens, which played a major role in his plans. The second Versailles soon won a reputation as an entertainment venue. However, the lavish festivities and extravagant lifestyle eventually drove Albert into bankruptcy. He lost the château and spent the rest of his life in seclusion. This marked the end of the most glorious era in the château's history.

THE RUINS OF FULŠTEJN

Experience the romantic atmosphere at the ruins of Fulštějn **Castle** near Bohušov. The castle on the hill was probably built in the middle of the 13th century by Herbort of Fulm and existed until

the Thirty Years' War, during which it was destroyed. The castle has never been restored and the ruins are freely accessible to all tourists.

MEDIEVAL FRESCOES

Go to the nearby village of Hrozová and discover a real gem. In the local Church of St. Michael the Archangel, you can admire the uncovered, preserved medieval frescoes from the 13th century. These are unique in the whole of Central Europe!



Our Lady in the Rock

OUR LADY IN THE ROCK

Head to the valley near the town of Spálov. By the River Oder, which symbolically divides Moravia and Silesia, you will find a beautiful pilgrimage site. At the spring, which flows directly from the rock, you can contemplate for a while by the stone altar and the statue of the Virgin Mary. Legend has it that a mortally wounded soldier miraculously recovered here during the Swedish Wars.

TAKE A WALK ON THE SILVER TRAIL

Take the educational trail with a poetic name - Stříbrný Chodník (Silver Trail). The route refers to the history of silver mining at the Moravian Gate. The educational trail is about 10 kilometres long and has a total of 16 stops. It will take you past forests, wetlands and ponds and you can also enjoy the view of the town of Odry. Signs along the route provide information about the fauna and flora and the history of the settlement of the Oder region.

IN THE MILL WHERE THE KING RULES

In the unique Wesselsky Water

Mill, with a family tradition dating back to the 16th century, you can learn to drive a miller's carriage, taste delicious cherry chocolate, and even stay the night. Mr Král, the miller, will introduce you to the curiosities of the miller's craft. He will tell you why millers were the foundation of the nation's technical intelligence. And if you want to relax a bit, you can get a picnic basket and rest in the meadow behind the mill, enveloped in the pleasant aroma of dozens of species of herbs.

MORAVIAN HOLLAND

Did you know that there were 700 windmills in North Moravia and Silesia? In the past, people in this region managed to make the most of the wind. Get to know the smallest Dutch-style windmill in the country. In 1929, František Baler built a windmill near Spálov very similar to those on the endless Dutch plains. The shining white mill operated for only a few years, until 1938.

If you would like to see the tiny Balerův Mill from the inside, then you can pick up the keys at the Spálov municipal office.

TO THE BIRTHPLACE OF THE FOUNDER OF GENETICS

Take cycling path number 503. From Starý Jičín towards Jeseník nad Odrou to Vrážný, you can enjoy a ride along the recently opened cycle path complete with colourful injections of the Moravian-Silesian dialect. In Vrážný, turn towards Hynčice - the birthplace of the founder of genetics, Johann Gregor Mendel. The famous naturalist demonstrated the laws of genetics by experimenting with the crossbreeding of peas. Thanks to the exhibition at the scientist's birthplace, you will learn many interesting facts about his life.

Fulnek

THE TOWN OF FULNEK

Did you know where the teacher of the nation and the most successful Czech tennis player of today were born? Yes, Jan Ámos Komenský and Petra Kvitová are connected by Fulnek. This historic town, one of the greatest jewels of the Baroque era, was founded in 1293. Fulnek formed part of the Amber Road, an ancient trade route which connected the countries around the Baltic Sea with the countries on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea. The unmistakable landmarks of the town are the Fulnek Château on the hill and the Baroque church standing on the site of an earlier Medieval church.

CHURCH OF THE HOLY TRINITY

One of the most beautiful Baroque churches in Moravia, the Church of the Holy Trinity in Fulnek, was built in the middle of the 18th century by the Augustinian order of priests. The church is exceptional for its unique fresco decoration, which includes the "Biblia pauperum", a picture Bible for the poor. It is the only church in the Moravian-Silesian Region to have a preserved Gothic cloister. It is a truly unique work of Medieval art, which can be admired today in a form almost unchanged from the beginning of the 15th century.

HEIPARK TOŠOVICE

A local patriot once made his dream come true by "buildin" an artificial hill in the Oder Hills. In the winter there is skiing and in the summer it comes alive with excited families on the bobsleigh track, tubing, trampolines, rope course, giant slides, golf course, bike park, and archery range. After you've tried everything, jump in the local swimming pool to cool off!

BARTOŠOVICKÝ MLÝN

You will find an almost fairy-tale water mill in Bartošovice, right on the old border between Moravia and Silesia. And not just any water mill! Not only does it have its own small hydroelectric power plant, but it even has fully functional mill technology. You can see (and hear!) it in operation during special tours called The Mill Comes Alive, which will tell you if you're really "up to it".

THE MYSTERIOUS LANDSCAPE **OF SLATE**

Follow the traces of slate mining through a mysterious landscape of vanished mine workings, slate heaps and lakes formed in flooded mining pits. If you look carefully, you may even discover fossils of animals and plants. The slate trail with a total length of approximately 50 kilometres crosses the surroundings of the towns of Budišov nad Budišovkou, Svatoňovice and Čermné ve Slezsku. It is up to you which of the 6 circuits you will take and whether you will walk or cycle along

them. All of them are connected to each other by clearly marked paths equipped with information boards. However, you must not miss the Budišov Slate Museum on your journey to find the black treasure, which even covers the roof of the National Theatre. Here you will learn all about the history of mining and see various curiosities such as a slate gramophone and a slate gramophone record. The highlights of the tour are visits to the Flascharuv Dul and Raabovy **Štoly Mines**, which are the only accessible slate mines in the Czech Republic.

THE LITTLE MORAVIAN MIRABELL

The Mirabell and Kunín Châteaus are linked by the personality of Johann Lucas von Hildebrandt. This world-renowned architect worked for many noble families, including the Harrachs. Between 1726 and 1734, he built for the Harrachs a Baroque country château and a place of rest in Kunín. A few years earlier he had also rebuilt the Mirabell Palace in Salzburg. The Kunín Château is connected with the fascinating story of Countess Marie Walburga. After the death of her children, she founded an educational institute, the Philanthropinum, which soon became the focal point of

education in Moravia. Czech and German children of all social classes and religions studied at the school. The children studied from morning to night in all subjects, took trips around the area, ate healthy food and kept fit. However, many people were not in favour of innovation in education. The Institute was therefore abolished. The Countess, entitled "the First Lady of Moravia", took the end of her life's work very hard. She could only rejoice at the thought of the hundreds of children who had received a unique education thanks to her. One of these was **František** Palacký, the father of the nation and a native of nearby Hodslavice.

V LIPKÁCH CHAPEL

Explore the lesser-known sights of the Jeseníky Mountains and discover beautiful remote corners. One hidden gem is V Lipkách **Chapel** in Rýmařov, which is considered a pearl of the North Moravian Baroque. The building on an elliptical floorplan was constructed as early as 1710. Not far from this branch of the **Church** of the Visitation of the Virgin Mary stands Janovice Château. This Late Gothic fortress was built as early as 1520, and the château acquired its present appearance in the 19th century.

LEGENDS COME TO LIFE

Discover the spooky and mysterious atmosphere of Sovinec Castle in Jiříkov in the Bruntál Region. The original fortress was built in the 14th century and is shrouded in many legends and unexplained phenomena. Some legends claim that the source is revenge by the ghost of a young girl who was entombed inside the walls of the castle. It is up to you what you believe, but the castle was chosen for its atmosphere by Juraj Jakubisko for the film Bathory. So summon up your courage and take a walk through the beautiful restored premises with magnificent views of the surroundings.

ENCHANTING WATERFALLS

Venture into the almost untouched nature of the **Rešovské Waterfalls**. This natural gem is located just a few kilometres from Rýmařov. Here you can admire the rich and impressive cascades and waterfalls created by the narrow River Huntava in the canyon-like valley. The highest level is 10 metres high, and a mill formerly operated under the waterfalls. The entire area is protected as a national nature reserve.

UNIQUE FRESCOES

Unique archaeological findings from the beginning of the 13th century confirm the location of the original town of Bruntál - the oldest town with documented town rights in the Czech lands - in the vicinity of the Church of the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin Mary in the Old Town. Once you pass through the main entrance with its Romanesque portal, you will find yourself going back 700 years in time. Some of the rooms have been preserved almost unchanged and you can learn more about the significance of the church thanks

to the new exhibition in the interior. On entering the sacristy, you will then again travel back several centuries in time to the Gothic phase of the church in the second half of the 14th century. You can admire beautiful Medieval frescoes. According to experts, the paintings resemble those by the Master Theodoric, who became famous for his decoration of the chapel at Karlštejn.






